PIKE LAKE AND WATERSHED MANAGEMENT PLAN DEVELOPMENT	Lake management activities on the lake in the early years were centered around improving the fishery and controlling the abundant aquatic plants found in the lake. A dam that raised the lake approximately 1.2 feet was constructed in 1949 to prevent movement of fish downstream at times of high water and to maintain a ordinary lake levels. Aquatic plant treatment began in 1940 and continues to today. Fish planting also began in the 1940's.
