Chetek Lakes Water Quality Management Plan	The water quality of Chetek Lakes has degraded considerably since they were last studied in 1996. Because the cause of this deterioration is unknown, Barr recommends that a new study be undertaken to determine the cause of the deterioration. The cause could be the watershed, which includes cropland, or internal sources, such as phosphorous being released into the water column from sediment and phosphorus being released into the water column from decaying plants.
