Purpose: Legend Lake Protection and Rehabilitation District (LLPRD) proposes to control Curly Leaf Pondweed in Legend Lake by implementing control measures during the period 2010-2012. The project elements and deliverables are specified in the LLPRD\2019s Aquatic Invasive Species Control Grant application, dated December 30, 2009. The project includes conducting pre- and post-treatment surveys; controlling Curly Leaf Pondweed with aquatic herbicide treatments; and implementing an aquatic invasive species prevention strategy that includes developing an information & education program. Annual progress reports and a final report summarizing the two-year project will be provided to DNR.
