 Specific project activities include: 1) CBCW, Project RED, & CLMN AIS monitoring trainings; 2) AIS Media campaign; 3) AIS boat landing signs inventory & installation; 4) AIS monitoring; 5) AIS outreach & education; 6) Foster relationship with Sheriff for enforcement of AIS laws; 7) Develop county wide AIS strategic plan.
 Deliverables include monitoring data entered in SWIMS, maps and associated GIS files, educational materials developed, and a county-wide AIS Strategic Plan.
 Special Conditions: 1) Sponsor shall contact DNR immediately if a new AIS is found; 2) New AIS infestations shall be vouchered and entered in SWIMS; 3) AIS monitoring personnel shall be trained and follow DNR approved protocols; 4) Education materials shall be consistent with the Department's 2019s statewide education strategy for preventing and controlling AIS.
